

BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION PROGRAM

David

Behavior	Intervention	Consequences	Criteria
<u>Hyperventilating:</u> When David breathes excessively and loudly when overstimulated or excited.	1. "David, calm down/get ready." In a deep voice.	1. Pass: "Thank you!" 1. Fail: Move to #2.	One to two episodes of hyperventilating per day.
	2. "David, calm down/get ready." In a firm voice.	2. Pass: "Thank you!" 2. Fail: Move to #3.	
	3. "Time out" in a firm voice. Place David in a chair. Vary placement of chair.	3. Pass: Sits quietly-immediately can get up. "Thank you!" 3. Fail: Stays in chair until calm.	

Special Considerations:

Consistency is a key for David!

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Behavior	Intervention	Consequences	Criteria
<u>Aggressive Behaviors:</u> When David brings his mouth in contact with adult/peers body and bites down; when David brings his hand in contact with adult/peer and slaps and/or scratches.	1. "Stop!" In a firm voice and sign stop	1. Pass: "Thank you!" 1. Fail: Move to #2.	One to two episodes of aggressive behaviors per week.
	2. Pull away from person, say "Be nice!" and model positive touch	2. Pass: "Be nice, thank you!" 2. Fail: Move to #3.	
	3. "Time out" in a firm voice. Place David in a chair. Vary placement of chair.	3. Pass: Sits quietly immediately can get up. "Thank you!" 3. Fail: Stays in chair until calm.	

Special Considerations:

It is important to be consistent when using this procedure.

Continue to chart behavior on the data collection form.
